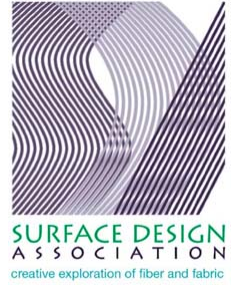


For SDA members: You can utilize this website and our blog in three ways:

- A. Promote your own work through a Member's page
- B. Promote your event on our News Blog.
- C. Promote your event on our Home page



A. Member's Pages: If you are an SDA member and wish to have a Member's page on the BC SDA website, please send to [Cher Cartwright](#) as follows:

1. Contact information that you wish to have on your page (name, place of residence, any or all of: website, email, phone)
2. image of your work (should be postcard size: 4" x 6" or 10cm x 15cm - 72 DPI) - 'Portrait' format, as opposed to 'landscape' required. Also send a very short description of the image item as per this example:

POST NO BILLS
Thread painting; Rayon & cotton sewing thread
40"x28"

3. Short bio/artist statement: Max 100 words. See other Member's pages for examples.

A one-time fee of \$10 is payable for Member's pages, to help cover the operating costs of the website. Please send your cheque to: Catherine Nicholls, 718 4th Street East, North Vancouver, BC, V7L 1K2

B. To promote your event or announcement on our NEWS Blog:

Please send info to [Jennifer Love](#) as follows:

- details of the great thing you want to tell us about
- event dates, title of show or workshop, name of artist(s), name of gallery/facility, address, phone number of the facility
- dates and hours when the exhibition can be seen or the event is taking place
- opening reception date and time, if relevant
- your website address and/or that of the gallery or other venue

C. Home page announcement:

If you have a **great image** and would like to request that your announcement be placed on the HOME page of our website, that may be possible. Even if we don't have the space for your announcement there, we'll add it to our NEWS blog. Please send information and image to [Jennifer Love](#) as follows:

- all the same information as for the News Blog
- a lo-resolution jpg (approx. 72 dpi) of one of your pieces with the title, materials and size, just as you would when submitting a work to an exhibition. 'Portrait' format (as opposed to 'landscape') preferred. This should be a fairly recent piece.
